said he used to sell 150-200kg of chicken every week, but in the last two weeks, sales have declined to 70kg per week. Sukhdev Vatishnau, who runs a general store at Varca, said that he is forced to sell eggs at Rs. 80 due to an Increase in supplier prices.
