s the afternoon sun shines over Ku-nariya, 20km from Bhui, an unu-sual hum fills the air — not the fa-miliar tinkle of bangles at the vil-lage well, but the gentle purr of two-wheeler engines, punctuated by excited squeals and bursts of self-conscious laughter. Here, women between 20 and 50

years gather every day at 3pm, their faces lit with determination as they take com-mand of their

The driving session — they call it the '3PM (Iub' — has become a sanctuary of hope for 33 women, each carrying her own aspirations. Those who have mastered riding the two-wheeler have already approached the gram panchayat, requesting car driving lessons — a reflection of their growing confidence and determination to push boundaries.

Take Geeta Kesariya, a 39-year-old entrepreneur whose business spans tailoring, embroidery and sanitary napkin sales. Her greatest hurdle is getting her products to customers. "I currently send my goods through busser isking dam-age and dealling with impredictable timings," she explains, her frustru-tion evident. "Once I learn to ride the two-wheeler, I can deliver every-thing myself." With her family firmly behind her ambitions to master both two-wheeler and car, ster both two-wheeler and car, Geeta's eyes light up as she shares

her journey "Learning to drive a car is my dream," she says. The learn-ing curve has been steep but excit-ing. "There was a two-wheeler at home, but I didn't even know where to put the key," she laughs, recalling her first lesson. "I started with the basics like understanding what's an accelerator, a brake, a clutch. It was

Perhaps the most moving story is that of Rubina Node, a 29-year-old who supports her differently-abled parents through her sewing work. BJP candidate Ramesh Bidhuri expresses regret after row erupts over his 'roads like Priyanka Gandhi's cheeks' remarks

New Delhi: BJP candidate from Kalkaji Ramesh Bidhuri on Sunday drew flak for his remarks that he would make reads which are like Congress leader "Priyanka Gandhi's cheeks" in his constituency, with the Congress demanding an apology from him for "insulting women" and some leaders in his party also expressing their disapproval. Bidhuri, who has courted controversies in the past too over his statements, initially remained defant, pointing remained defant, pointing

remained defiant, pointing to similar remarks by RJD leader Lalu Prasad on actor and BJP MP Hema Malini.

However, he later posted a message on X expressing re-gret if his comments had

gret if his comments had hurt anyone and stated that his remarks had been misconstrued by some for political gains. "Lalu said in Bithar that he would make roads like Hema Malini's cheeks, but he lied, he could not do it. "I assure you that just as we made the roads in Okhla and Sangam Vihar, we will make all the roads in Kalkaji like Priyanka Gandhi's cheeks," Bidhuri is heard saying in the purported video, which went viral on social media. The Congress con-

demned the remarks, alleg-ing it reflected the "antimg it renected the anti-women" mentality of the BJP. "Ramesh Bidhuri's statement regarding Priyan-ka Gandhi is not only ex-tremely shameful but shows

tremely shameful but shows their ugly anti-women think-ing. But what else can be expected from a man who used foul language against his fellow MP in the House and did not receive any punishment?

"Not only Bidhuri, but the BdP's top leadership should apologise with folded hands," Congress spokesperson Supriya Shrinate said, adding it was not only an in-

sult to Priyanka Gandhi but to all women

Asked about the Con-Asked about the Congress' demand for an apology. Bidhuri sought to defend himself by saying, "If this is a mistake, then the one who committed it first should apologise. Isn't Hema Malini awoman?"

Accusing the Congress of hypocrisy, he said, "Hema Malini was from a simple family, is she not a woman? The one who is from a known family is a woman a known family is a woman."

a woman, how is it possible? 'Hema Malini is from the South, does that mean that she is not a woman. Everybody Prasad) apologise, they did not ask for it because she was from a simple family. It is their hypocrisy," Bidhuri told re-

hypocriss," Bidhuri told re-porters.

Delhi B.IP chief Virendra
Sachdeva stressed that such statements should be avoided. "We should not make such statements and should exercise restraint in our lan-guage. I would also tell the Congress that when such remarks are made against our MP Hema Malini, you don't stop it. Having said that, re-spect for women and maintaining control over our lan-guage is our duty and such statements are not welcomed

us," he said. BJP MP Kamaljeet Sehra BJP MP Kamaljeet Sehravat said, "A politician should say anything after giving a thought foit." As the row esca-lated, Bidhuri, a former two-time MP from South Delhi and three-term MLA from Tughal-qabad, in a post on X claimed that his remarks were being misinterpreted by some for political gain. "It was not my intention to insult anyone. Still, if any person has been Still, if any person has been hurt then I express regret," Bidhuri saidX. **n

According to forest officers, parts of a peacock's body were found in the leopard's mouth, while its feathers were strewn around the spot. The wire was about 10 feet above the ground while the power house's boundary wall net was also about 10 feet high.
