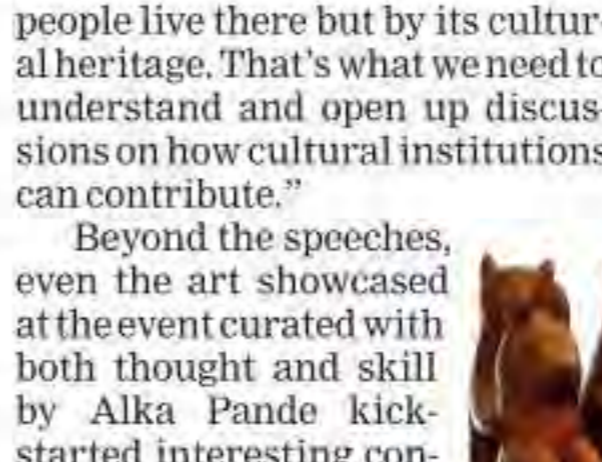
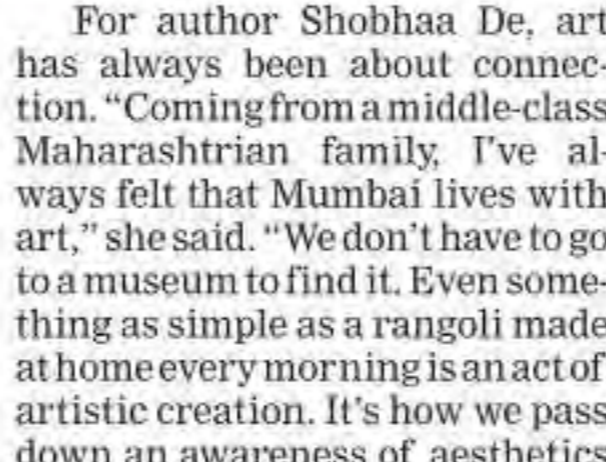

"For the first time in 40 years, people of more than 130 polling stations in the worst Maoist-affected districts of Sukma and Bijapur cast their votes and participated in the festival of democracy," said CM Sai.

Locals of Puwanti, the native village of dreaded Maoist commander Hidma, also turned out to vote.

"Reports of the end of Naxalism and the victory of democracy bring a sense of deep satisfaction," the CM said, adding: "In Bastar division, the influence of the ballot is now overtaking the bullet. This is the first time that Naxals have not opposed panchayat elections in Bastar."

Sai said this had been possible due to the establishment of more than 40 new security camps in highly sensitive areas by govt. "The final nail in the coffin of Naxalism, which has been a cancer for Bastar, is being hammered in by our 'double engine' govt," the CM said.

The most recent security camp—a CRPF forward operating base—was opened in Bijapur district's Pujarikanker area on Feb 13. The camp is strategically located to aid in the construction of a crucial road linking Bijapur with Usur and Pamed, one of the worst insurgency-affected regions. "As per the resolve of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and home minister Amit Shah, the eradication of Naxalism in Bastar is set to be achieved by March 2026. This is the victory of democracy over the forces of terror. Jai Bastar, Jai Chhattisgarh!" said CM Sai.

Voting began at 6.45am and ended at 2pm in Bastar division. The results will be announced Tuesday.

2 more GBS deaths in Maha take India toll to 21

Pune/Nagpur: India's death toll from Guillain-Barré Syndrome (GBS) in the current outbreak rose to 21 as two more fatalities—one each in Pune and Nagpur—were reported on Monday.

With this, Maharashtra's death toll has risen to 17. Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Tamil Nadu and Bengal account for a death each.

Maharashtra health department on Monday listed the death of a 34-year-old resident of Wagholi in Pune at Sassoon General Hospital on Saturday evening as a GBS fatality. With this, nine people have died in

Pune since the outbreak of the rare neurological disease in the city on Jan 5.

An official said he was brought to the hospital after he experienced a tingling sensation in the limbs followed by loss of strength in both legs, which progressed to the upper limbs within six hours. "This loss of power in all limbs progressed rapidly over the next three days and by Feb 8, he had lost strength in the neck, respiratory and facial muscles. He had trouble swallowing too," the official said, adding that the patient never regained this strength.

One more GBS death was confirmed in Nagpur, taking

the total count in the city to two. The victim, an 8-year-old boy, was admitted to Government Medical College and Hospital (GMCH) Nagpur on Jan 16 and he succumbed to the illness on Feb 10. However, at the time of death, his GBS diagnosis was not confirmed. At GMCH, several patients are still battling GBS. Among them is a seven-year-old girl who is on mechanical ventilation and continues to be in a critical condition.

Meanwhile, Union junior minister for AYUSH, Prataprada Jadhav, Monday hinted at the possibility of travel restrictions in affected areas if the disease is found to be contagious. "If the disease is spreading from one region to another, imposing travel restrictions may become necessary. Discussions between the central and state health departments are ongoing to address the situation," Jadhav told reporters in Buldhana.

Toddler killed in celebratory firing at wedding procession in UP

Nonin: A two-and-a-half-year-old boy was killed after a man allegedly opened a celebratory fire during a wedding procession here, police said on Monday. A case has been registered against the accused and efforts are on to arrest him, officials said.

High faecal coliform levels in Prayagraj at Kumbh: CPCB

NGT Says Report Points At Several Non-Compliances

New Delhi: The national green tribunal was informed on Monday through a report by the CPCB that various locations in Prayagraj during the ongoing Maha Kumbh were not conforming to the primary water quality for bathing with respect to the level of faecal coliform.

Faecal coliform, a marker of "sewage" contamination, had a permissible limit of 2,000 units per 100 ml, according to the central pollution control board. An NGT bench was hearing the test of pre-existing sewage discharge to the Ganges and Yamuna rivers in Prayagraj.

The bench noted that the CPCB had filed a report dated Feb 3 pointing out certain non-compliances or violations. "The river water quality was not conforming to the primary water quality for bathing with respect to faecal coliform (FC) at all the monitored locations on various occasions. A large number of people bathe in the river Prayagraj during the Maha Kumbh Mela which eventually leads to an increase in faecal concentration," it said.

The bench also noted that the Uttar Pradesh pollution control board had not complied with the tribunal's earlier directions to file a compliance report. The tribunal observed that the UPPCR had only filed a covering letter with certain water test reports.

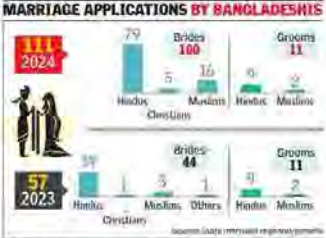

Convict gets two life terms for 2017 Goa rape-murder

Accused Had Confessed To The Crime But Later Retracted His Statement

Margao: A Goa court on Monday gave two life sentences to Vikram Bhagat, who was convicted last week for the 2017 rape and murder of a 29-year-old Irish national in Canacona. The sentencing brought closure to a legal battle that lasted eight years.

Additional district and sessions judge Kestham Ji, who had convicted Bhagat on Feb 19, pronounced the quantum of punishment by sentencing the 31-year-old to two rigorous life imprisonment - one under IPC Section 302 (murder) and the other under 376 (rape).

"The sentence of imprisonment for life shall run concurrently," the order said, meaning that Bhagat will serve his natural life in prison. The court also imposed a fine of Rs 25,000 for each of these offences.

Additionally, Bhagat re-

tracted a three-year sentence for obstruction of evidence under section 201 IPC with a fine of Rs 10,000. Bhagat is a former police constable. Police discovered injury marks on Bhagat's groin and legs, believed to have been sustained during the assault. The victim's blood was found on his clothes and shoes, and investigators recovered blood-stained clothing near his residence in Canacona. "Because there was no witness and he took her into the forest where he committed these crimes, it was difficult to get the prosecution to put the circumstantial evidence together," Varma said. PCV of Margao court, who was in charge of the case, said Bhagat, who was known from previous visits to India, in the hours before her death.
